Official Tournament Rules

Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively to the Tournament Committee.

The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters.

PARTICIPANTS AND ELIGIBILITY

Participation in the Tournament is open to all persons who are 18 years of age or older. Persons under 18 may register and participate if a registered parent or guardian is in the same boat.

REGISTRATION

A properly completed and signed official application accompanied by the \$60.00 entry fee must be received by tournament officials no later than BLASTOFF. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry. You may pre-register by mail, or by visiting SEMINOLE OUTDOORS.

SAFETY

Each competitor must wear a Coast Guard approved chest-type life jacket any time the combustion engine is operating and on plane. Reckless boat handling which in any way might possibly endanger any contestant or non-contestant will result in immediate disqualification.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Competitors are expected to adhere to a high standard of sportsmanship and courtesy. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the boats. Any act of a competitor which reflects unfavorably on the efforts to promote conservation, clean water, and sportsmanship shall be reason for immediate disqualification. Polygraphs may be requested at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. All live wells will be checked at check-in. All fish to be released by designated boat. Not in canal.

TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT

Only artificial lures may be used for bass. Only one casting, spincasting, or spinning rod may be used at any one time. All bass must be caught in a sporting manner. Trolling is prohibited. No Baiting of holes will be allowed. All state and federal regulations apply. Violation of any rule is grounds for disqualification.

BOAT AND MOTOR

Fishing boats must be a minimum of 12 feet in length. All boats used are subject to approval or disapproval by the Tournament Committee. Every boat must have all required Coast Guard equipment. Every boat participating in bass fishing must have operating aerated live wells and running lights.

PERMITTED FISHING LOCATION

Fishing will be permitted anywhere on Lake Jackson, with the exception boat ramp to take off @ Sunset Landing or within 50 yards of an anchored Tournament boat with the trolling motor stowed. (Power Pole acceptable anchor). Boats may check in at any time, however once checked in they may not relaunch for the duration of the tournament.

OFFICIAL CHECKPOINT

Sunset Landing is the official checkpoint for the check-in and take off. Take off will begin promptly @ 6:00 pm in an orderly fashion. Boat position will be determined by order of entry. Check in is 10:00 pm. All teams must have chip turned in to tournament official by 10:00 pm. Late penalty is disqualification of catch. Last place points still awarded.

SCORING

Only largemouth bass will be weighed. The aggregate limit shall be 5. Only bass as described above which measure 12 inches or more from closed mouth to the tip of the tail shall be presented at weigh-in. Culling of dead fish prohibited. Scoring will be based on the cumulative weight of the total catch of each boat. 4 ounces will be deducted for each dead fish. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st, 100; 2nd, 98; 3rd, 96 etc... 5 bonus points awarded for big bass. No fish will receive last place points -10. Tie breaker will be most fish, big fish then split. Championship based on top 50% standings after best three tournaments. Points stay with captain. Must fish at least two tournaments to qualify.
